Vestry Meeting Minutes  
June 6, 2006

The regular monthly meeting of the Rector, Wardens and Vestry of St. Agnes Episcopal Church, Little Falls, N.J. was called to order at 7:55 P.M. with a prayer led by Father Neglia.

**Minutes:** A motion, to accept the minutes of the May 2nd meeting (as amended) was made by T. Ploch, 2<sup>nd</sup> by W. Drake-Schneider and approved unanimously.

Business Items:

4. **Every Member Canvas Date:** Every Member Canvas Sunday will be October 22<sup>nd</sup>.
5. **Power Squadron Lease:** In response to counter-proposal from the Power Squadron, asking that we agree to a \$500 increase for a period of 3 years, a motion to accept a \$500 increase for a period of 2 years was made by T. Ploch, 2<sup>nd</sup> by S. Cox and approved unanimously.
6. **SACC Lease & Increase:** Michelle Borden is going to be making a presentation to the SACC board regarding our lease agreement.
7. **July Supply Clergy:** The Rev. Gary Blumer will conduct our Sunday worship services during Fr. Neglia's July vacation.
8. **All These Pictures:** Tom Ploch is going to print out the pictures from the Children's Service that he had already posted on our web page. Pat Keating plans to make a collage with them.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by T. Ploch, 2<sup>nd</sup> by M. Borden and approved unanimously at 9:15 pm. Fr. Neglia led us in a closing prayer.
